**Incident Date and Time:** Friday, November 13, 2020 at 12:55 AM  
**Location:** El Camino Real at Center Street, Millbrae, CA.  
**Type of Crime/Incident:** Major Injury Collision

**Summary:**

On November 13, at approximately 12:55 AM, a car being driven Southbound on El Camino Real just South of Center Street in the City of Millbrae collided with a 30-year-old, male pedestrian who was in the traffic lanes. The driver stayed at the scene and assisted the pedestrian. The pedestrian had serious injuries and was taken to a local hospital by ambulance where he remains in critical condition.

Deputies from the Millbrae Police Bureau of the San Mateo County Sheriff's Office closed the southbound roadway of El Camino Real for a few hours to complete the investigation. The roadway has since reopened with no further impacts to traffic anticipated.
