Suspect Arrested for Arson, Commercial Burglary, and Vandalism in Unincorporated Redwood City Neighborhood

Location: 2900 Block of Flood Avenue, Unincorporated Redwood City, CA

Unincorporated Redwood City – On Sunday, September 24, 2023, at 8:07 PM, San Mateo County Sheriff's Deputies received a report of arson involving a vehicle on the 2900 block of Flood Avenue, in North Fair Oaks. The suspect was reported to be at the property when he set the vehicle on fire and the vehicle subsequently sustained major damage. The suspect fled the scene but was later located hiding in the area.

It was later determined that the suspect also gained access onto the property without permission and used spray paint to vandalize the property. The suspect, identified as **41-year-old Arnaldo Lucatero** was taken into custody without incident and booked into the Maguire Correctional Facility, where he is being held on \$25,000 bail.
