Incident Date and Time: Monday, June 20, 2022 at 11:05 AM
Location: 3200 block of La Mesa Drive
Type of Crime/Incident: Attempted residential burglary
Suspect: #1 – Black male adult, 20-30 years old, white shirt
#2 – Black male adult, 20 -30 years old, black hoodie

Summary:

On Monday, June 20, 2022, at 11:05 AM an unknown male suspect knocked on the victim's front door. The victim looked through the peephole and did not recognize the male suspect and declined to open the door. A short time later, the victim heard noises coming from the front of the house. The victim observed a second male suspect tampering with one of the front windows to the house. The victim called to another family member in the house and made their presence known. The second suspect acknowledged the presence of the victim and fled the property on foot.

Preliminary investigation revealed similarities to other recent burglaries. Video surveillance reviewed showed a vehicle of interest in the area at the time of the incident. Patrol Deputies are continuing to follow up on more video surveillance.
