Summary:

On Sunday, June 26, 2022, at approximately 0200 hours, Victim was walking home from Downtown Redwood City. While in the 2300 block of Bay Road she was approached by an Unknown Suspect. The suspect had his penis exposed and attempted to convince the victim to go home with him. She declined, attempted to walk away, and called a friend. While on the phone with her friend, the suspect caught up to her, grabbed her vagina, and took her cell phone from her. The suspect then fled on foot.

The Suspect was described as a Hispanic male in his 20's standing approximately 5'6". He was wearing a grey shirt and blue jeans. The victim also described him having a "fade" haircut and when he spoke to her, he spoke in English with no accent.
