Summary:

On 05/01/2022, at approximately 9:25 PM, deputies from the Millbrae Police Bureau of the San Mateo County Sheriff's Office responded to the 200 block of Adrian Rd., on the report of a commercial burglary in-progress at a self-storage business. A male, matching the description provided by witnesses, was located nearby. When deputies attempted to contact the subject, he fled. After a short foot chase, the subject was detained without incident. He was later positively identified by witnesses and found to have two outstanding warrants for his arrest.

A second male suspect was located as he exited the self-storage building. He was detained without incident and admitted to being involved in the burglary. Numerous stolen items were recovered at the scene as well as tools associated with the burglary. One victim of the burglary responded to the scene and was able to reclaim their property. Deputies are working to contact the owners of the remaining stolen property. Both suspects were arrested and transported to the Maguire Correctional Facility for booking.
