**Missing Person:** **Helen Kostomarow**, 68-year-old female

**Summary:**

On Thursday, April 28, 2022 at 09:13 PM, San Mateo County Sheriff's Deputies from the San Carlos Police Bureau responded to the above location on the report of an endangered missing person. Deputies learned that Helen Kostomarow was last seen leaving her residence on April 28<sup>th</sup> at 12:00 PM to go for a walk. When she did not return at 9:00 PM, the reporting party wished to report her missing.

Kostomarow is described as a Caucasian Female Adult, 5'5" tall and approximately 150 lbs. She has long gray hair and green eyes. Kostomarow was last seen wearing a light brown jacket, gray shirt, blue capri pants, sandals, and was carrying a black handbag. She is considered at risk due to age and a pre-existing medical edition.
