Joint Police Effort Results in Arrest of Suspect in Multiple Offenses

Location: Nottingham Avenue, Unincorporated Redwood City

Type of Crime: PC 422, 166, 647 (J)(4)(A), 12022.1

Suspect: Oliver Chavez Morfin, 25-year-old Hayward resident- *ARRESTED*

Unincorporated Redwood City, CA – On Friday, September 22, 2023, at approximately 5:16 PM, deputies were dispatched to a home on Nottingham Avenue in Unincorporated Redwood City on the report of a restraining order violation.

Upon arrival, the deputies initiated an investigation that uncovered several offenses linked to the incident. These included criminal threats made on social media, the sharing of private photos without permission, and the fact that the suspect was committing a felony while out on bail.

The San Mateo County Sheriff's Office contacted the Hayward Police Department for assistance and both law enforcement agencies teamed up to attempt to locate the suspect at his residence in Hayward. Unfortunately, the initial search did not yield results.

On Monday, September 25, 2023, the Hayward Police Department notified the San Mateo County Sheriff's Office of a significant development. They had successfully found and detained the suspect, who was identified as Oliver Chavez Morfin.

Upon receiving this information, deputies promptly met with the Hayward Police Department to take custody of Chavez Morfin. Chavez Morfin was then transported and booked into the Maguire Correctional Facility without incident.
