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Wage Garnishment Writ of Execution Sheriff Instructions

Court Document(s) Required:	Our Office requires wage garnishments to be served by a Registered Process Server (RPS) per Code of Civil Procedure § 699.080 and § 706.108. Prior to the levy, the RPS must open a file with our office and deposit with the Sheriff The original application for Earnings Withholding Order A copy of the Writ of Execution A copy of the Earnings Withholding Order Required fees The RPS must have in his/her possession the levy packet: upon opening a file with our office which consists of the following: Original Writ of Execution—Money Judgment (form EJ-130) Original Earnings Withholding Order Instructions to Employer form Employer's Return form Notice to the employee of the Earnings Withholding Order
Letter of Instruction	None. The Application for Earnings Withholding Order is required instead.
Time of Service	The Writ of Execution expires 180 days after issuance.
Method of Levy	The method of levy is the service of a wage garnishment on the debtor's employer. The employer is required to withhold and remit a percentage of the debtor's wages to the Sheriff as required by law (Code of Civil Procedure § 706.010 thru § 706.154) towards satisfying the money judgment. Our Office requires bank garnishments to be served by a Registered Process Server (RPS) per Code of Civil Procedure § 699.080 and § 706.108. Prior to the levy, the RPS must open a file with our office with required fees. After levy, the RPS must file with the Sheriff within five (5) days the following per Code of Civil Procedure § 706.108(d): Original Writ of Execution Proof of service on employer If required fees have been received by the Sheriff, the Sheriff will

	perform all other duties under the Writ of Execution and return the
	writ to the court with an accounting of action taken.
Fees	\$35.00 per service.
	\$35.00 if the RPS is unable to serve or cancelled.
Writ Return	A return detailing the Sheriff's actions is prepared by Civil Unit staff,
	which accompanies the original Writ of Execution when it is returned
	to the court. A copy of the Employer's Return is mailed to the
	judgment creditor upon being received by the Sheriff, which details the
	employer's action regarding the Earnings Withholding Order.

Registered Process Server (RPS) Check List:

- \$35.00 fee for each service
- Original Writ of Execution—Money Judgment (form EJ-130)
- Original Application for Earnings Withholding Order (functions as letter of instructions to the Sheriff)
- Original Earnings Withholding Order
- Instructions to Employer form
- Employer's Return form
- Notice to the employee of the Earnings Withholding Order
- Submit to Sheriff no later than 150 days after issuance of Writ
